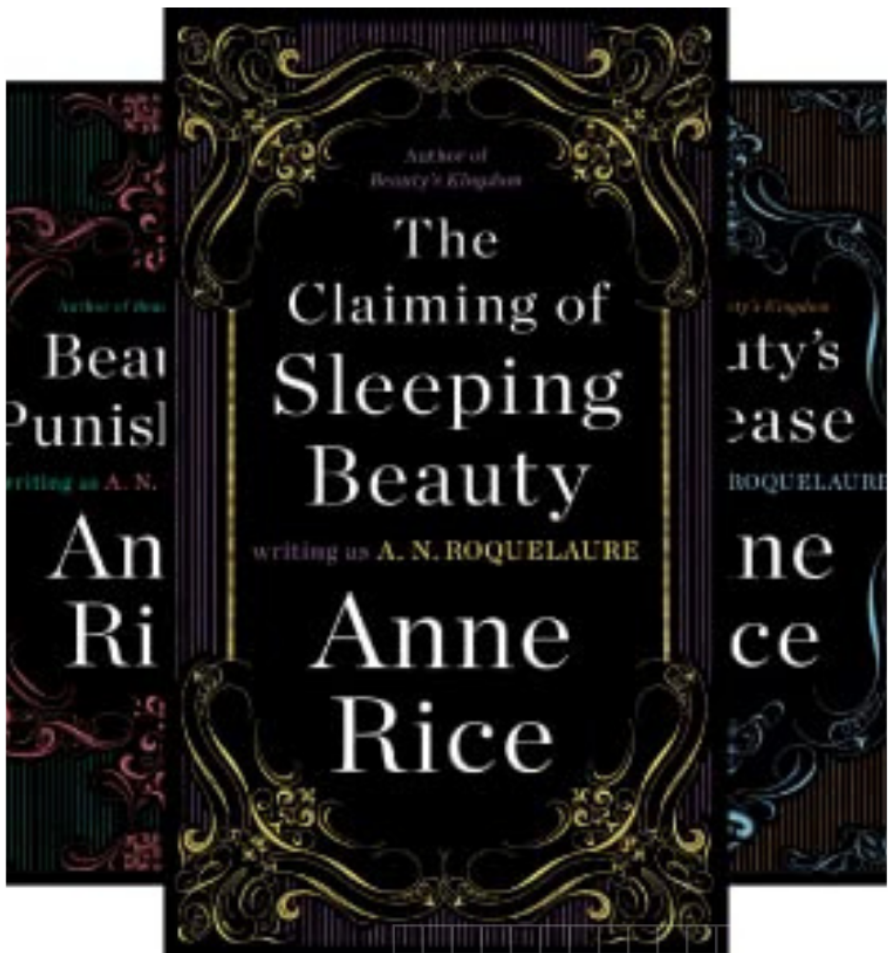


1. WHEN DID YOU REALIZE YOU WANTED TO BE AN AUTHOR?

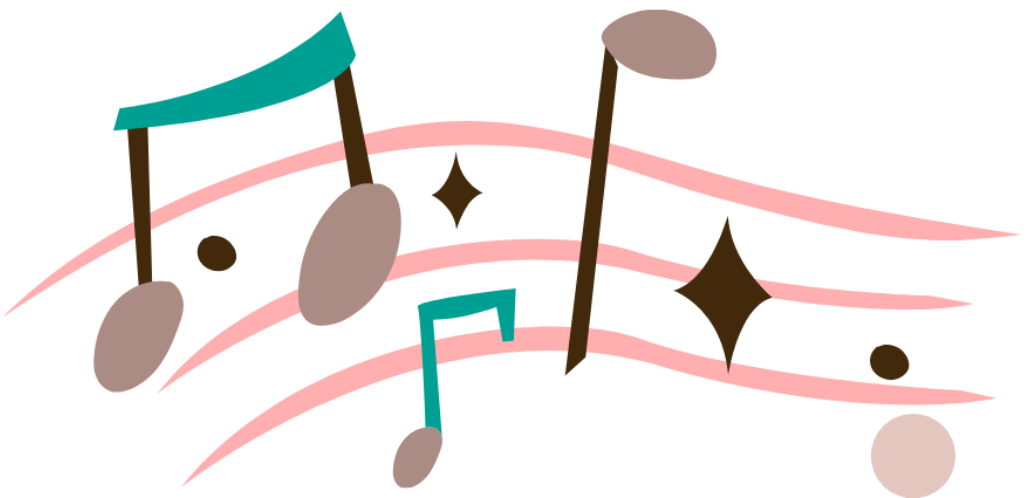


3. SONG THAT YOU LISTEN TO WHILE WRITING

If you mire in minutia, you'll sabotage your story and lose the organic matter.

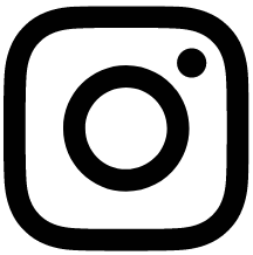


6. HOW DO YOU PUSH PAST A WRITER'S BLOCK?

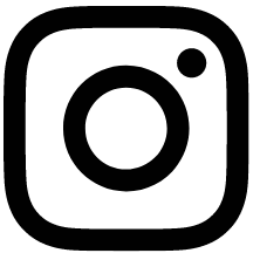
7. OTHER NEW AUTHORS THAT INSPIRE YOU

New authors that inspire me? Wow, there is so much talent out there but to name a few



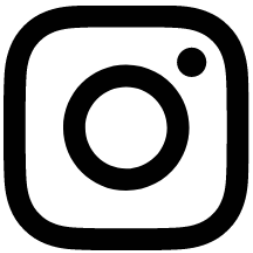

9. WHERE CAN READERS FIND YOUR BOOK FOREVER EVE AND UPCOMING BOOKS?

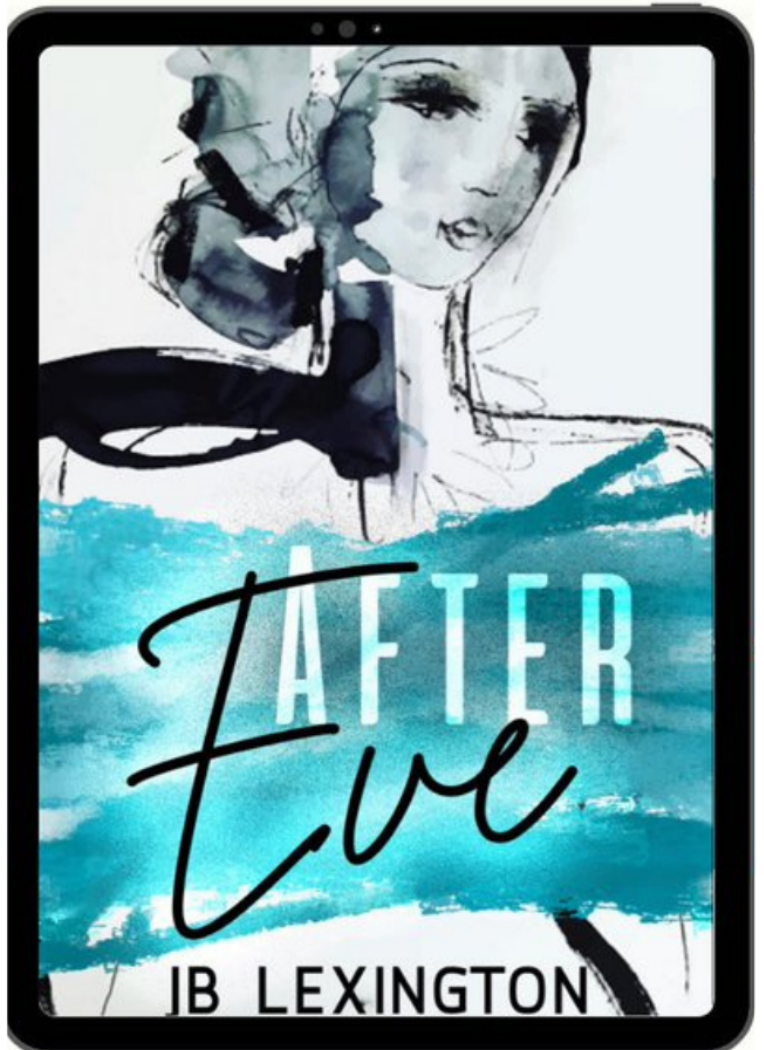
